

## The ECSC levy (1 January 1953 to 31 January 1954)

**Caption:** As of 1 January 1953, a general levy is introduced for the six ECSC countries. As a result of this tax on coal and steel output, the High Authority possesses its own resources and no longer depends on government subsidies.
