| 25.06.1950 | North Korean troops cross the 38th parallel and invade South Korea. |

| 26.06.1950 | North Korea rejects the cease-fire demanded by the United Nations Organisation (UNO). |
| 30.06.1950 | American troops are sent to South Korea by President Harry S. Truman. |
| 07.07.1950 | General MacArthur is appointed supreme commander of United Nations forces in Korea. |
| 15.09.1950 | Disembarkation of United Nations troops in South Korea. |
| 01.10.1950 | United Nations troops cross the 38th parallel. |
| 07.10.1950 | American troops cross the 38th parallel. |
| 16.10.1950 | China sends the first contingents to Korea. |
| 02.11.1950 | Clashes between United Nations armed forces and Chinese troops. |
| 26.11.1950 | General offensive launched by the Communist forces. |
| 15.01.1951 | The United Nations forces halt the Communist offensive. |
| 11.04.1951 | General Ridgway succeeds General MacArthur as supreme commander of United Nations forces in Korea. |
| 10.06.1951 | Beginning of the first talks in Kaesong. |
| 12.11.1951 | The United Nations forces cease all offensive operations. |
| 07.05.1952 | General Clark succeeds General Ridgway as supreme commander of United Nations forces in Korea. |
| 08.10.1952 | Adjournment of the armistice talks. |
| 04.11.1952 | Dwight D.Eisenhower is elected President of the United States. |
| 02.02.1953 | The United States call a halt to the neutralisation of the Formosa Strait. |
| 20.04.1953 | Beginning of prisoner exchanges. |
| 26.04.1953 | Resumption of the armistice talks. |
| 27.07.1953 | Signing of the cease-fire in Panmunjom. |
