**Caption:** On the occasion of the Copenhagen European Council meeting of 7–8 April 1978, the Heads of State or Government decide that the election of the members of the European Parliament by direct universal suffrage will take place from 7 to 10 June 1979.

Statement by the European Council, meeting in Copenhagen on 7 and 8 April 1978, on the election of the members of the European Parliament by direct universal suffrage

After examining dates suitable for the election they have reached agreement that the election to the Assembly shall be held from 7 to 10 June 1979.'
