

Resolution (74) 32 of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe (22 October 1974)

Caption: In 1974, following the decision of the Greek Government to hold free elections by universal suffrage after the fall of the 'Greek colonels' regime', the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe envisages inviting Greece to resume its place in the organisation and instructs the Secretary-General to submit a report that includes a draft invitation.

Resolution (74) 32 of the Committee of Ministers on the readmission of Greece to the Council of Europe (22 October 1974)

The Committee of Ministers,

Recalling Resolution (74) 27 on the situation of Greece, adopted on 20 September 1974 ;

Having taken cognisance of Resolution 578, adopted by the Consultative Assembly on 27 September 1974 ;

Noting the decision of the Greek Government to organise free elections by universal suffrage on 17 November next,

1. Envisages inviting Greece, in the course of the meeting to be held in Paris at the level of Ministers of Foreign Affairs at the end of November 1974, to resume its place in the Council of Europe ;
2. Instructs the Secretary General to contact the Greek authorities for the purpose of determining the practical arrangements for Greece's readmission and to submit at its next meeting at Deputy level a report on this subject including a draft of the invitation provided for in Articles 4 and 5 of the Statute.
