

### Resolution (56) 4 on the admission of Austria to the Council of Europe (8 March 1956)

**Caption:** On 8 March 1956, the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe adopts a resolution which invites Austria to accede to the Council of Europe and establishes, in particular, the number of seats to be allocated to Austrian representatives in the Consultative Assembly.

## Resolution (56) 4 on the admission of Austria to the Council of Europe (8th March, 1956) — (Adopted by the Ministers' Deputies)

#### Admission of Austria to the Council of Europe

The Committee of Ministers,

1. Noting that the Federal Government of the Republic of Austria has made known its desire to become a Member of the Council of Europe;

2. Noting that the Republic of Austria fulfils the conditions laid down in Article 4 of the Statute;

3. Recalling Resolution 9 (1951), in which the Consultative Assembly expressed the wish that the Committee of Ministers might seize the first appropriate opportunity to invite Austria to become a Member of the Council of Europe;

4. Having regard to the favourable opinion expressed by the Standing Committee of the Consultative Assembly,

Resolves:

(a) that the Republic of Austria be invited to become a Member of the Council of Europe and adhere to the Statute under the terms of Article 4 thereof;

(b) that Austria shall be entitled to six seats in the Consultative Assembly;

(c) that the Austrian contribution for the current year shall amount to 22,547,000 French francs and that its contribution to the Working Capital Fund shall be 5,400,000 French francs;

Instructs the Secretary-General to inform the Federal Government of the Austrian Republic of these decisions and to take all appropriate steps to put them into effect.
