Translation of Communiqué issued by the French Government

August 18th, 1948

The French Council of Ministers took note of the memorandum submitted by the I.C.M.E.U. referring to the convening of a Conference whose purpose would be to draw up plans for the organisation of a European Assembly.

The Council accepted the proposal of the Foreign Minister and decided that it would give its active support to the memorandum, and accordingly would take all these steps which might be thought appropriate.
