Composition

The composition of the European Parliament and the arrangements for appointing its members are governed by the treaties (Articles 14 TEU and 223 TFEU) and by the Act of 20 September 1976 concerning the election of the Members of the European Parliament by direct universal suffrage,¹ as amended most recently by the Council Decision of 25 June and 23 September 2002.² The allocation of seats by Member State for the eighth parliamentary term (2014–2019) is laid down in the European Council Decision of 28 June 2013.³
