Reply to Recommendation 293
on European union and W.E.U.

1. The Council are now studying the outline programme prepared at their request by the Standing Armaments Committee. In this context, governments of member States will ensure that the S.A.C.'s activities do not duplicate the work undertaken by the independent European Programme Group. The Assembly will be duly informed of their conclusions.

2. As stated in Article 10 of the Council decision of 7th May, 1955, setting up the S.A.C., agreements or arrangements drawn up within the framework of the Standing Armaments Committee remain open to participation by other allied countries. The Council have noted the statements made on this subject during the last session of the W.E.U. Assembly.
